RULES & REGULATIONS

1. An exhibitor must become a member of the Society by payment of \$2.00 annually prior to entering any class.
2. Competition for 2011 shall be open upon payment of entry fee specified.
3. An entry fee will be charged for each exhibit and shall be as listed within the enclosed prize list. All entry fees must be paid at the time entry is made.
4. Name, registration number, etc. of animal must appear on entry form of purebred livestock. Animals under one(1) year must be eligible for registration. Exhibitors of purebred stock must produce certificate of registration when required to do so by the Judge or Director in charge.
5. All livestock and articles exhibited must be bona fide property of exhibitor and have been so for at least thirty days prior to the date of the fair. Any infringement of this rule will cause forfeiture of any and all prize money.
6. In livestock classes, an exhibitor may make two entries in the same class provided entry fee is paid for each individual entry.
7. All exhibits in horse and cattle classes must be shown and judged in the ring to be eligible for the prize money.
8. A grade foal must take its breed from the sire and must be shown in the class indicated for animals of such breeding.
9. All animals must be shown or paraded in the ring whenever so ordered by the judge.
10. Cows must show plain evidence of producing a calf in 2011.
11. Any animal being carried as a nurse cow is not eligible for competition in any class.
12. The directors in charge may reclassify any animal or item that has been incorrectly entered.

13. The judges' decision will be final unless appealed in due form. Every appeal must be in writing, and must be in the hands of the secretary within two (2) hours from the time of the decision, and must be accompanied by \$20.00 for each exhibit in question, which will be returned only if the appeal is sustained.
14. If the quality of the livestock does not warrant a first prize even though there may be no competition, the judge will award only the prize the exhibit warrants. Judges will be instructed to withhold any premium for any unworthy exhibit.
15. **LIVESTOCK MUST BE ON THE GROUNDS BY 9 AM, JUNE 25, 2011.**
16. **LIVESTOCK ENTRIES FOR ALL CLASSES WILL BE RECEIVED FROM 6:30 – 9:00 PM ON FRIDAY, JUNE 24 AND FROM 8:00-10:00 AM SATURDAY, JUNE 25, 2011 AT THE SHOW RING OFFICE. SORRY, NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER THIS TIME. PLEASE MAIL THEM IN ADVANCE. YOUR CO-OPERATION IS APPRECIATED SO THE JUDGE'S BOOKS CAN BE MADE UP PRIOR TO SHOW.**
17. All livestock exhibits must remain on the grounds until 6:00 pm, June 25, 2011 unless given special permission to leave by the horse or cattle committee Chairman. Prize money will be forfeited if exhibitors fail to comply with this regulation.
18. All prize money won will be paid by cheque, which will be forwarded to the winning exhibitors as soon as possible after close of the fair.
19. The directors reserve the right to limit total prize list to an amount equal to the net receipts. In the event of net receipts being insufficient to allow the prize list being paid in full, each prize list will be reduced pro rata, accordingly and all entries are made and received on this distinct understanding. This regulation applies to every class of entry at the fair.
20. The directors will use every precaution for the preservation of all articles or stock exhibits but will not be responsible for loss or damage. Exhibitors must be prepared to take full charge of their exhibits at time stated for release, namely 6:00 pm June 26, 2010.
21. The directors are not by law responsible to any one exhibitor or spectator, for any loss, damage or injury that may occur in any animal or things on the premises of the Society.
22. Split Cattle shows of different breeds will be allowed, if the number of entries warrants, i.e. 20-25 head of Herefords, or a combination of breeds. The directors of the cattle committee will make the decision. The same amount of prize money will be awarded for each show. If a regional breed show is held in any year, that breed will have its own show and prize money.

2011 KILLARNEY AGRICULTURAL FAIR
HORSE COMMITTEE RULES

1. No stallion to be shown by a junior exhibitor.
2. The show judge may measure all horses and ponies.
3. In registered classes, papers must be provided upon request.
4. All exhibitors should be neatly and appropriately dressed, including boots.
5. Birthdays are as of January 1st of the current year. Seniors – 19 years and over; Juniors – 18 years and under; Peewee – 12 and under.
6. An amateur is one who has not shown, judged, trained, or assisted in training a horse for remuneration for the past five calendar years.
7. Any entry not in the ring five minutes after the class is called may be disqualified at the judge's discretion.
8. A horse is over 14.2 hands and over. A pony is under 14.2 hands. A miniature is 38 inches or less.
9. There shall be no cross entries in any classes.
10. **MGRA classes are marked with an *.**
